Pursuant to the state open records law, Cal. Govt Code Secs. 6250 to 6276.48, I write to request access to and a copy of:

REQUESTS DERIVED FROM SOS WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL

- Section 5.** The vendors plan and jurisdiction - use procedures to prevent viral propagation of malicious software from one system component to another.
- Section 18.** The vendor - ROV report specifying detailed uniform requirements and use procedures for vote results auditing and reconciliation, review of audit logs and retention of election documentation to validate vote results and detect unauthorized manipulation of vote results.
- Section 22.** The ROV log of the jurisdiction users to record all problems and issues with the voting equipment in the polling place as reported by voters or observed by poll workers.
- Section 32.** The ROVs Elections Observer Panel Plan.

If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodians name and address.

I agree to pay any reasonable copying and postage fees of not more than \$10. If the cost would be greater than this amount, please notify me. Please provide a receipt indicating the charges for each document.

As provided in the open records law, Sec. 6253(c), I will expect your response within ten (10) business days.

If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material.

I would note that willful violation of the open records law can result in the award of court costs and reasonable attorney fees. See Sec. 6259(d).
